

<p><b>Day 2 - 10<sup>th</sup> Dec / 7<sup>th</sup> Jan</b></p>  	<p><b><u>Jaipur (Capital City of Rajasthan)</u></b> Jaipur the <b>Rajput City</b> is a land of forts, palaces and temples, the city that stands out for its unique design and layout is Jaipur, the "<b>Pink City</b>". Built in 18th century by Maharaja Sawai Jai Singh II and his architect-builder Vidyadhar. Basically this is the city of culture, tradition and crafts. This day your tour will include the imposing <b>City Palace</b>, still home to the Maharaja although several of the rooms are now open to the public. Many antiques and artifacts belonging to the ruling family are housed here, including a collection of weaponry. <b>Hawa Mahal (Wind Palace)</b> Also admire from where the palace queen could watch the activities of big bazaar. Jaipur is also famous for its textiles. The Bagru block print is the fashion designers craze and the Bandhej (tie and dye) print is very typical of the region. Visit live demonstration of block printing in cotton/silk textile industry where 100 of labors working for more than 14 hours a day. (Try, fit or order a new Indian comfortable traditional outfits (for Ladies/Gents) which would be stitched/designed as per your gentle size in just few hours). Evening on leisure. <b>Welcome Dinner</b> .Overnight at Jaipur. Accommodation : Pre - Booked Hotel B,D ( Included )</p>

**Day 3 - 11<sup>th</sup> Dec / 8<sup>th</sup> Jan**



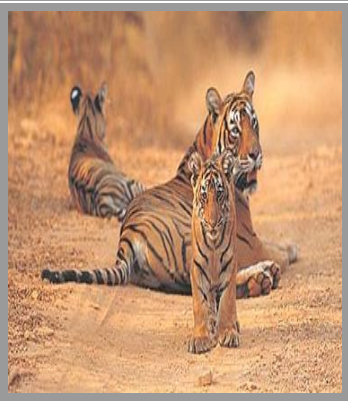
**Jaipur (Capital City of Rajasthan)**

Morning excursion to impressive **Amber Fort** situated on a ridge just outside Jaipur City. At the foot of the hill you will mount your caparisoned elephant for the slow but steady climb up to the main gate, making your entrance in the time honored fashion. Fort, completed in the early 18th century, took over 100 years to build and now, although deserted, offers a fascinating insight into the lifestyle of the Moghul ruling families. **Lunch at Ethnic restaurant** with its unique **TURBAN MUSEUM**, displaying the various types of turbans wears by persons of different categories. A must-do in Jaipur is **shopping** - jewellery, handicrafts, clothes and the famous lakh bangles as Jaipur is one of the most active jewel markets of the world, famous for its precious and semi precious stones. Visit traditional bazaars of Jaipur city (**Babu Market**). Later transfer to Hotel for relaxation of few hours.

**Dinner & evening-** with Cultural entertainment, Rides & Rajasthani Folk Dances at ethnic village resort "**Chokhi Dhani**" from where you can en-counter with culture and tradition of whole Rajasthan. (**Chokhi Dhani is an ethnic village where you enjoy your meal sitting on the floor mat on banana leaf which is very old royal traditional & style of India with various selection of Rajasthani vegetarian food**).

**Jaipur-Ranthambore ( Tiger Reserve )**

Morning by private air-conditioned transport transfer to Ranthambore ( app 4 hours ) . After Lunch **jeep/canter safari** accompanied by a naturalist takes you on an exciting journey inside the **jungles of Ranthambore**, where the remains of a thousand-year-old fortress, have been reclaimed by nature. Today, it is a **wildlife sanctuary**, where **leopards and tigers** prowl the ruins. Ranthambore is one of the few preserves where the nocturnal, camera-shy tigers may be seen in daylight. You'll enjoy thrilling game drives in the morning in search of wildlife. Back to the hotel . Evening view the jungle **slide show & enjoy special rajasthani tea & cookies**. Relax & **Evening Cultural Rajasthani Dances & Special Jungle Dinner**. Overnight at Ranthambore . Overnight at Ranthambore.

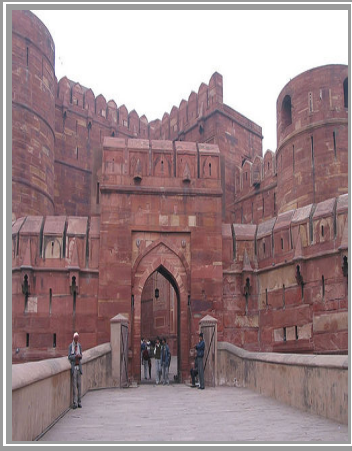


**Ranthambore - Fatehpur Sikri - Agra (City of Taj Mahal)**

Besides perfect symmetry in every aspect of its construction, the inlay work of semi precious stones into marble in pietra dura style is absolutely remarkable later lunch at famous city restaurant. Later visit **inlay marble factory**, live show of works man ship by the workers inlaying the one stone in another from the time of Mughals, Observe the handicrafts & leather goods. Evening on leisure. Overnight at Agra.

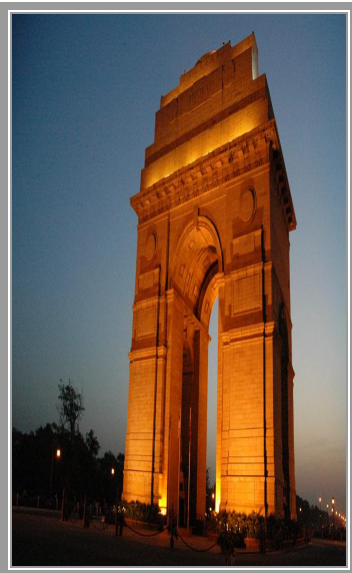


### **Agra(City of Love)**

Lunch at famous **South Indian restaurant** to recognize the taste of South Indian cuisine as India is well known for its various delicious cuisines. Drive pass through the **Red Fort** (Built in 17<sup>th</sup> century-ex .of Mughal architecture) , then visit **Raj Ghat** ( Mr. M.K.Gandhi cremation place ) , **India Gate**(42m stone arch built in the memory of Indian soldiers ,died in World War II). **Parliament House, the Presidential Palace, Secretariat Buildings**.

Later in evening transfer to International airport to a catch flight for onward destination.
