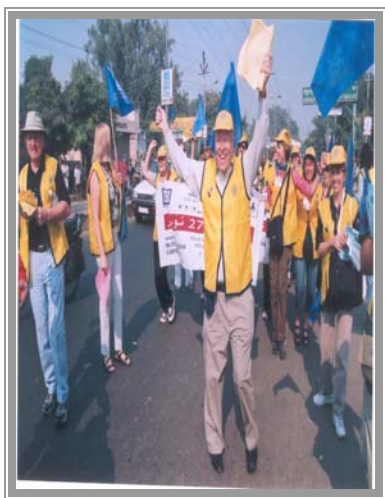
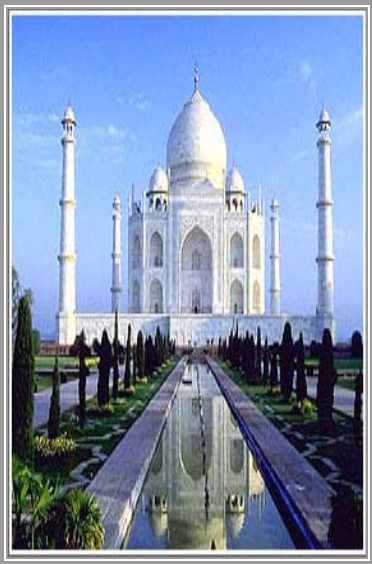

Besides perfect symmetry in every aspect of its construction, the inlay work of semi precious stones into marble in pietra dura style is absolutely remarkable , **back to hotel & enjoy breakfast** , Relax , afternoon **Check out** , visit **inlay marble factory** live show of works man ship by the workers inlaying the one stone in another from the time of Mughals , Lunch at **famous city restaurant as India is well known for its delicious cuisine**.

Later, At 14.00 Hrs take part in **Polio Rally/Road Show, wearing Polio Message Aprons & Caps (covering 4 Km , app 45 Min to 1 Hour)** with the loud speakers on rickshaw cycle which sounds some regional songs with colorful balloons printed the message of polio eradication. This is very exciting and meaningful. 1 day prior to Polio Surveillance Round . At Rally you will get chance to express your feelings and ideas before the public, about polio eradication from India with **advertisement banner of your district**. You can distribute the **pamphlets** which mention the prevention and safety from polio disease. **Evening welcome dinner , fellowship dinner**

Morning at 8.00Am attend the Inaugural function at CMO (Chief Medical Officer) compound with DM & Commissioner, further transfer to **Polio Booths & D/Type Help Post (by Cycle/Auto Riksha/Tuk Tuk)** with the advertisement **banner of Polio NID** & also visit nearby **Malin basti (slum areas)** in city & personally give the **Polio drops** , small gifts- **pencils ,rubber , pens , masks , stickers** , etc to the children's .There you will accompany with volunteers doctor who helps you to give two drops to children's to the age of 5 years. Later have opportunity to go door to door for giving polio drops in slum areas. Your noble work and presence will encourage the people who are not aware about polio disease or who are not taking interest in this program. This charitable work can secure the future of the children and nation.

In your honor farewell **Indian dinner** hosted by Rotarians where once again interact with them and transfer your experience and ideas about Polio activities in Agra India and brief talk on Indian-Western culture and lifestyles.

Ranthambore (Tiger Reserve)

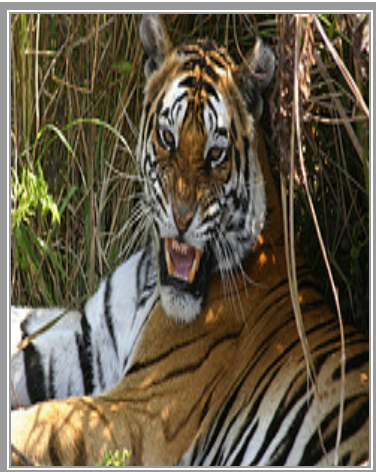
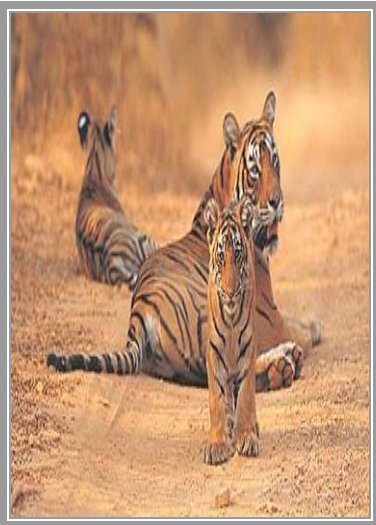

Later visit live demonstration of block printing in cotton/silk textile industry where 100 of labors working for more than 14 hours a day. (Try, fit or order a new Indian comfortable traditional outfits (for Ladies/Gents) which would be stitched/designed as per your gentle size in just few hours) & check-in .

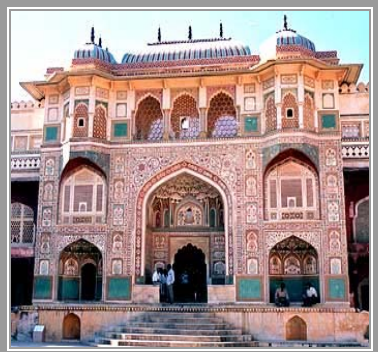
Dinner & evening- with Cultural entertainment, **Bull & Camel Rides** & Rajasthani Folk Dances at ethnic village resort "**Chokhi Dhani**" from where you can encounter with culture and tradition of whole Rajasthan.
